YARD WASTE

The City of Essex welcomes city residents to bring their yard waste to the yard waste pile on Airport Road (across the highway from Casey's). Yard waste is grass, leaves, garden waste, brush and trees. Yard waste is not any type of treated lumber (for example an old deck).

Are you unable to haul your yard waste to Airport Road? Give City Hall a call. We can pick it up for you for a small fee.

Did you know that you can burn your yard waste? If you want to burn the hours are Monday through Saturday from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Please no burning on Sundays, and no burning of garbage.

ORDINANCE HIGHLIGHTS

Mowing

- Grass no longer than 6 inches
- Do not blow grass clippings into the street

ATV/Golf Cart/UTV

- These vehicles must have a permit issued from City Hall
- All vehicles must obey all traffic laws
- Golf cart operators must be 16 years old or older
- ATV/UTV operators must be 18 years old or older
- Permits are valid January December
- Permit sticker must be clearly displayed on vehicle
- One permit per vehicle stickers are not transferable

Animal Control

• Dogs and cats are not to be running "at large" (off leash or out of their yard)

Fireworks

- July 1 July 3 until 10:00 PM
- July 4 until 11:00 PM
- Please be respectful of your neighbors & community by obeying posted times for the use of fireworks and picking up firworks waste & trash

Cemetery

• The City & Cemetery Board requests that you help keep the grounds clean by removing unwanted grave decorations. Trash cans are available.
